




Writing Prompts HALLOWEEN THEME



How to use this resource:

- 1. Prompts can be used to create a class theme day or party.
- 2. One prompt can be selected daily, leading up to Halloween.
- 3. Use prompts to facilitate class discussions, encouraging students to share their thoughts and perspectives on a given topic.
- 4. Use idea prompts to kick off a lesson or unit, sparking students' interest and setting the stage for further exploration.
- 5. Prompts could be used to generate ideas for student projects or research assignments, guiding them to explore topics in more detail and apply their knowledge.
- 6. Assign prompts as homework to extend learning beyond the classroom, giving students opportunities to work independently.
- 7. Use prompts as themes for bulletin boards or classroom displays, showcasing student work and celebrating their creativity.
- 8. Use two prompts to organize a "would you rather" game or to organize a classroom debate to develop argumentative and public speaking skills.
- 9. Create learning stations with different prompts, allowing students to rotate through and explore various aspects of the subject.
- 10. Incorporate prompts into peer review sessions, where students give feedback on each other's work based on specific criteria.

Food Themed

- 1.Famous Spooky Treat: Write a report about a famous Halloween dish from another country. Describe its ingredients, how it's prepared, and the tradition behind it.
- 2. Creepy Creation: Invent a brand-new Halloween food product. What's it called? What are its ingredients? Why would trick-or-treaters love (or fear) it?
- 3. Haunted Feast: Imagine you've been invited to a Halloween banquet in a haunted mansion. What eerie dishes are served, and what happens when you take a bite?
- 4. Monster Food Critic: You're a vampire, witch, or zombie writing a review for a new spooky restaurant. Describe the food, how it looks, and how it tastes (to monsters).
- 5. The Great Halloween Bake-Off: You've entered a baking contest judged by ghosts! Describe your dessert, the secret ingredient you use, and what happens when it's tasted.
- 6. The Pumpkin's Journey: Write a story from the perspective of a pumpkin from growing in the patch to becoming a jack-o'-lantern or a delicious pie.
- 7. Witch's Café Menu: Create a menu for a Halloween café or potion shop. Name your dishes and describe what makes them magical, spooky, or strange.
- 8. Time-Traveling Trick-or-Treater: You can travel through time to celebrate Halloween in three different eras. What kinds of treats or traditions do you discover?
- 9. Alien Halloween: Imagine aliens celebrating Halloween for the first time. What strange foods or candies do they invent on their planet?
- 10. Culinary Curses: Create a story about a haunted recipe book that comes to life. VVhat happens when someone dares to bake from its pages?



- 4. Message from the Moon: On Halloween night, the moon begins to whisper messages to you. What does it say?
- 5. Pumpkin Patrol: The pumpkins in your neighborhood start walking around at midnight. VVhere are they going?
- 6. The Ghost's Secret: You meet a friendly ghost who needs your help. What unfinished business does it have?
- 7. The 100-Year Party: You receive an invitation to a Halloween party that's been going on for a century. VVho's there?
- 8. The Witch's Apprentice: You accidentally become a witch's apprentice for the night. What spells do you learn—and what goes wrong?
- 9. The Scarecrow's VVish: A lonely scarecrow in the field wishes for just one Halloween where it's not alone. Tell its story.
- 10. The Midnight Library: On Halloween, your local library comes alive. The books whisper, the portraits move, and you find one book with your name on it...
